

INTRO TO ONCEFALLEN REENTRY OUTREACH (UPDATE 03/26/2026)

This intro explains what the OnceFallen.com offers & doesn't offer. (If you wrote to SOSEN, the organization went defunct in 2024; I was/am answering letters on their behalf.) Please read this then share it with others in need of my services. To Contact OnceFallen:

Due to the negative connotations, we discourage the use of "SO" as much as possible & use Person Forced to Register (PFR), RC (Registered Citizen), RP (Registered Person), or Registrant to describe those who are released & on the public registry. SO is generally used sparingly & for those not yet released from incarceration. Anti-Registry Activists frequently use these acronyms so get acquainted with them: SCOTUS (Supreme Court of the United States), ARM (anti-registry movement), AWA (Adam Walsh Act, the federal registry law), SOR (S*x Offense Registry), SORNA (SOR & Notification Act), & FTR (Failure to Register).

ABOUT ONCE FALLEN

I am Derek Logue, a PFR, an activist since 2004, & host of the info site OnceFallen.com since 2007. I have a BS in Justice Studies (Athens State U. in AL, graduated 1999) & have made a handful of media appearances over the years, including HLN, Russia Today, & CNN, as well as various local media outlets across the US. I engage in public demonstrations as well as speaking before lawmakers. I am regarded as one of the most knowledgeable individuals on the subject of "SOR" Laws in the US. Still, I'm just a volunteer with a limited income. My primary function is running the Once Fallen informational site, which includes collecting, organizing, & writing articles on various topics related to the registry, residency restriction laws, or other issues of primary concern of those forced to register upon release.

All of the information on my website www.oncefallen.com is free to the general public for non-commercial use (i.e., personal reading & research, sharing with others, using pages as part of info packets when writing to legislators, & similar uses).

WHAT I OFFER AND WHAT I DO NOT OFFER

I answer letters by prisoners sent by mail or emails sent through Corrlinks (but NOT JPay or GTL/GettingOut). My focus is on issues a PFR may face upon release from incarceration. Please see below for the various resources that I offer prisoners. I'm a one-man operation with a limited budget that receives HUNDREDS of letters & emails a year, & stamp prices have skyrocketed in recent years so please respect my time as an unpaid volunteer. Below are my own rules on writing me. If you fail to follow my requirements, I will NOT respond to your inquiries:

WHEN WRITING LETTERS: Please write legibly (PRINT or TYPE, no cursive or fancy script). Use the EXACT writing address for regular mail, NOT for legal mail. Please know the right address, as some states are now requiring regular letters be sent to a central location, not to the facility. Even if you've written me before, please add reminders to prison mail policy if making a request (Examples: 5 single sided pages, 5 double sided pages, cannot use "security lined" envelopes, only B&W stamps, etc.)

IF MAKING A DONATION OR PAYING FOR PRINTOUTS: Make checks & MOs out to Derek Logue; if sending stamps, please send stamps I can easily peel & place on envelopes, or send stamped envelopes. Every five sheets of paper plus envelope require one stamp to send.

IF SENDING ME A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE: Write the proper mailing address for standard mail on the envelope (FL, TX, MO, PA, & WI use a central mailing location); **NO NOT** use your address labels, because even if your facility printed them out for you, they will likely still reject the return envelope. And don't forget your prisoner #!

What we DO NOT offer under ANY circumstances:

I DO NOT offer legal services, appeals issues, attorney referrals. DO NOT send me your case files. Any opinion I offer is not an attorney's opinion; it is just my opinion as an activist with some legal knowledge. State Bars or Legal Aid societies offer the services you need.

I DO NOT cover news on sentencing guidelines, prison-related issues or legal news not relevant to post-release SO laws: We may publish an occasional article related to these issues from time to time in the ICoN, but will not be able to answer questions related to these topics.

I DO NOT provide info on Pen Pals, People-Finding Services, or message forwarding services of any kind.

I DO NOT provide free copies of my book, Your Life on The List. You can ask someone to print a copy off my website for you, but I lack the funds to do that.

I DO NOT provide publishing services & I DO NOT want your life story, case file, or legal papers. I will NOT publish your life story, nor will I print out large volumes of material for you (that includes my book since it is around 200 pages long). I may occasionally send some material to assist on research related to post-release issues if the request is reasonable.

I DO NOT use any other correctional email service besides Corrlinks. JPay & GTL/GettingOut websites never works right & is expensive to send messages.

Your Life on The List 2025 Edition is a registry survival guide, covering a variety of common concerns like housing, employment, compliance checks, travel, & other common questions. It also contains a housing list & a comprehensive overview of the registry, residency/ proximity laws, & other post-conviction laws you may experience as a Registered Person.

If you want print copies, they are currently \$19.99 plus shipping/taxes on both Amazon and eBay. It is \$5 cheaper (\$14.99 plus taxes/shipping) if you buy directly from the publisher; they also offer bulk discounts (\$11.99 each if ordering 10+ copies at a time). (NOTE: The 2025 edition is printed in 8.5x11 in format; previous editions were 9x6 in format; this saves on print costs.) The publisher contact info is:

LIFE ON THE LIST (LOTL) NEWSLETTERS

The "Life on the List" Newsletter is a quarterly newsletter with news on important legal cases and legislation and news articles of interest to those forced on the list upon release. It is 10 pages long (so it can be printed on 5 sheets of paper and sent in a single envelope to most places) and new editions will be made available the 15th of March, June, September, and December. I will not have a physical mailing list so you'll have to find someone to print it yourself. (I may occasionally send a complimentary copy upon request but I ask you send a SASE or stamps or cover the cost). NOTE: If I have enclosed a copy of the latest LOTL Newsletter in this envelope, I offer this as a complimentary copy. However, as previously noted, I don't offer a subscription service to ship by mail at this time.

POTENTIAL HOUSING LISTS

Previous copies of this YLOTL contained a housing list. Because the housing list constantly changes, I am not including it in the YLOTL4 PDF. You can find the housing list on the oncefallen.com website, where the most current list is divided alphabetically by states A-M & states N-Z.

Prisoners & those w/o Internet access can contact me directly for a version of my housing list that contains all my leads including those NOT listed publicly on my website. It differs from my Internet list as I post only names, addresses, phone #s, & symbols denoting the type of service it provides. Because I'm adding non-public housing leads to this housing list, it is NOT to be posted in any public manner & if it happens I will stop providing this list. That version is updated every time I update my website's housing list. To help offset the cost, I ask prisoners to send two stamps or a SASE w/ 2 stamps on it if you can to help offset the cost.

Because I'm a one-person operation & there are currently over 400 listings, I can't guarantee every lead is still valid. IF you reach out to any housing lead on my list & get no response or are told they don't accept RPs, please notify me about it. And please share any potential leads you DO have.
