

**FLORIDA MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES AFFECTING PERSONS FORCED TO REGISTER: SHORT VERSION****Database created by Derek W. Logue of OnceFallen.com, Most Recent Update: 1 SEPT. 2026****ABOUT THIS DATABASE**

Under Florida law, certain Registered Persons (i.e., persons forced to register for inclusion on the state's sex offense registry) are subject to residency restriction laws. The state's Residence Restrictions are found at: Florida Statutes (FS) §775.215. Florida conviction for offenses that occur on or after October 1, 2004, & for extra-jurisdictional/"out-of-state" offense for offense occurred on or after May 26, 2010: A person who has been convicted of a violation of FS §794.011, §800.04, §827.071, §847.0135(5), or §847.0145, regardless of whether adjudication has been withheld, in which the victim of the offense was less than 16 years of age, may not reside within 1,000 feet of any school, child care facility, park, playground, or swimming pool. State law also creates "Presence Restrictions" or proximity laws, i.e., laws that state you cannot loiter or be present at or near certain locations: **(NOTICE! Chapter No. 2026-17 (CS/CS/CS/SB 212, took effect 7/1/2026) added "public swimming pools" to list of both residency and presence restrictions; increased presence restrictions from 300 ft. to 500 ft., and allows warrantless arrests for violations of presence restrictions.)**

- RPs with conviction involving a minor cannot "loiter or prowl" within 500 feet "of place where children are congregating," & face restrictions on ability to be present in schools & parks with exceptions. FS §856.022
- For those whose offense was committed on or after May 26, 2010: It is unlawful for an RP to knowingly approach, contact, or communicate with a child under 18 years of age in any public park building or on real property comprising any public park or playground with the intent to engage in conduct of a sexual nature or to make a communication of any type with any content of a sexual nature. FS §856.022
- RPs on supervision cannot visit schools, child care facilities, parks, & playgrounds except with approval, & is there for religious reasons or if the parent of a child using the area. FS §948.30

**HOW TO READ THE DATABASE**

Categories are listed as follows (Note: See Definitions for further descriptions of terms used here):

- **Municipality/Co. Gov't:** Name of gov't entity/corporation; County gov't will have its own entry, noted by the abbreviation "(Co.)". Note that the county governments are allowed to pass ordinances that can apply countywide or only to unincorporated areas.
- **County:** The County in which the incorporated community is located. Some communities may span multiple counties.
- **Pop.:** Population of municipality or county
- **Residency Restrictions (RRs):** Measured in feet; if no ordinances exist, it will say "NA" but state restrictions still apply; a question mark ("?") means no definitive evidence of an ordinance or lack of one can be found; 1000 ft. statewide RRs still apply.
- **Presence Restrictions (PRs):** Any distance where you cannot be seen "loitering" (marked by an "A"), "be present within or near" (a "total presence ban" marked by a "B"), or a complete ban that includes a ban on even traveling through a restricted zone ("T"); distance is in feet. If no ordinance exists (marked by NA), or no ordinance could be confirmed (marked by "?"), then statewide presence restrictions of 500 ft. apply. "OP" means "on premises". "PB" stands for park ban.

- **Apply To:** The Registrants to which the additional rules apply. It should be assumed everyone listed as a “sexual predator” is subject to the restrictions; however, in many cases, the law may state it applies to those convicted of offenses against those under age 16 (“Off<16”) or age 18 (Off<18), which usually also applies to CP offenses. If they do not state any exceptions, it is assumed to apply to everyone forced to register. While not listed in this report, there are a number of exceptions to the ordinances. See the code for exclusionary details. Note: Some older codes use the term “sexual violator” typically defined as offenses against someone under age 16 or 18.
- **“1st Pass”:** The date the municipality first passed a restriction ordinance. Generally, a mention of the date the ordinance can be found in municipal codes footnotes, except if superseded by a newer ordinance. This is intended to track the spread of ordinances across the state.
- **Current Ord/Code:** The section in the municipal/county code of ordinances where the ordinance can be currently located.
- **Prohibited areas:** There are few points to remember regarding restrictions:
  - The prohibited areas are almost always going to involve children; “places where children congregate” is a commonly used phrase in codes/ordinances and can denote any place the municipality or county deems to be used primarily by children.
  - Unless otherwise noted, prohibited areas generally only apply to PUBLIC areas; they don’t typically don’t apply to privately owned areas like a private park or playground unless explicitly stated in the ordinance. County ordinance might also apply to incorporated areas (cities).
  - Additional notes regarding municipal/county codes impacting Registered Persons will be added to this section such as:
    - Emergency shelter provisions (identifying as a Registrant and/or being forced into a segregated shelter, like the Co. jail)
    - Registry fees
    - Anti-Clustering laws (laws preventing Registrants from occupying same bldgs. or within a set distance of another registrant)
    - Halloween/holiday activity restrictions as specifically noted in the codes (bans on passing out candy, dressing in costumes, attending parties/ festivals, and/or decorating houses, with exceptions)
    - Employment bans, such as bans on working as a delivery/transportation driver (cab, Uber, Lyft, etc.)

### COUNTY NOTES

**BREVARD COUNTY NOTES:** Broward County passed an ordinance that it calls the "Business self-certification registry", allowing a business to register as a park.

**HAMILTON COUNTY NOTE:** The OPPAGA 2024 report claims there is a countywide ordinance for Hamilton County but I cannot confirm this since there is no information about it anywhere online. None of the communities or the county itself has published their municipal codes online.

**HERNANDO COUNTY NOTE:** The OPPAGA 2024 report claims Hernando County's restrictions are countywide, but it may be a misread of Sec. 21-232; that section reads "regardless of whether the" (prohibited area) "lies within unincorporated Hernando County." In this instance, it is referring to applying residency restrictions to a residence near/at the border of the county if a prohibited location is in the next county. No part of the ordinance explicitly states whether the ordinance applies to the sole incorporated community within.

**INDIAN RIVER COUNTY NOTE:** The OPPAGA claims Indian River County's residency restrictions/Sec. 306.06 ordinance is countywide; My review of the county notes states that only the registry fee/ Sec. 306.07 ordinance was noted as applying countywide.

**LEE COUNTY ADDITIONAL NOTES:** Any county/state/federal law that is more restrictive than those of Ft. Myers or Lee County is enforced over the limits in their codes (See Ft. Myers Code §50-146, Lee Co. Code §19-56)

**MIAMI-DADE COUNTY NOTES:** The Miami-Dade County Ordinance nullifies ALL municipal codes to create a unified countywide ordinance that applies to all municipalities equally. This covers all 34 Miami Dade Cities—Aventura, Bal Harbour, Bay Harbor Islands, Biscayne Park, Coral Gables, Cutler Bay, Doral, El Portal, Florida City, Golden Beach, Hialeah, Hialeah Gardens, Homestead, Indian Creek, Key Biscayne, Medley, Miami, Miami Beach, Miami Gardens, Miami

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Lakes, Miami Shores Village, Miami Springs, North Bay Village, North Miami, North, Miami Beach, Opa-locka, Palmetto Bay, Pinecrest, South Miami, Sunny Isles Beach, Surfside, Sweetwater, Virginia Gardens, and West Miami.

**NASSAU COUNTY NOTES:** The definition of “facilities” in the Nassau Co. Residency restriction code was so long, it could not fit in the spreadsheet. See Nassau Co. Code, Sec. 194-26 – Definitions: “Facility means those areas of real property for which a zone or area of protection is established. They are defined areas and locations devoted to use, and which possess a character and usage, which makes them places where children regularly congregate in, concentrated numbers. They are further described as: Places of public amusement or attraction such as auditoriums, arenas, bowling alleys, exposition and fairgrounds, waterslides, miniature golf courses, theaters and stages or other facilities for film or the visual and performing arts, and the like; state, county, municipal, and privately owned community centers, youth centers, parks, playgrounds, and recreation centers; athletic and recreational facilities and venues, including baseball fields, basketball courts, football fields, parks, pools, public or private golf courses, racquetball courts, soccer fields, tennis courts, volleyball courts, and skate parks; bathhouses and public restroom facilities; boat ramps, docks, fishing piers, marinas, public beach access and dune walk-overs; camps, family day-care homes, nurseries, and child care facilities, whether public, religious, or private, including, but not limited to, those licensed by the department of children and families; churches, temples, and places of worship, which have child-care, youth centers, and/or regular religious instruction and programs for youth; private, religious, or state, county, and municipal buildings, which have day-care facilities, and/or schools and institutions of learning, (but specifically excluding jails and places of adult or juvenile detention). “Schools” shall also include public or private school designated bus stops; facilities devoted to health care needs of children, including the clinics, offices, and medical facilities of doctors, dentists, orthodontists, optometrists, and other health-care providers, clinics, and the like which are devoted to the health-care needs of children.”

For Presence Restrictions: It shall be unlawful for any sexual offender or sexual predator to be present in any public or private park or within two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet of any public beach access or dune walk-over, or upon or within any other recreational facility that is open to the public when: (1) A child under the age of sixteen (16) years is present in that park or within fifty (50) feet of such public beach access or dune walk-over, or within the boundaries of such other public recreational facility; and (2) Specific notice, as provided in this division, is provided by posting the facility at its entrance or entrances, or, absent specific entrances, every one hundred (100) feet along the boundaries thereof. It is not specified in the code that the residency/proximity restriction ordinances are in effect countywide; while the 2024 OPPAGA report claims that it is, only the registry fees (Div. III of Ch. 194, Art. II) states that “This division shall apply to incorporated as well as unincorporated areas of the county.”

**OSCEOLA COUNTY NOTES:** Osceola County Code, Sec. 14-78. – Applicability, states, “This article shall apply to, and be effective within the unincorporated areas of the county and within incorporated Osceola County, to the extent that the ordinance does not conflict with any municipal ordinance covering the subject matter, activity or conduct regulated herein.” This applies to Kissimmee. There is a conflict between the city of St. Cloud and the County; the county adds school bus stops, libraries, and “other place(s) where children regularly congregate” to the list of prohibited places, while St. Cloud does not.
